

**THE "FIXED" 70x7 years - שבעים שבעים נחתך [Daniel 9:24]**

**ABRIDGED CHART**

In BC 465 - Artabanus assassinated Achaemenid king Xerxes, had the crown prince (Darius) executed and usurped control of the state.  
 In BC 464 - The next in line for the throne, Artaxerxes, slaughtered Artabanus in a fight, restoring the Achaemenid dynasty.

<sup>\*0</sup> Artaxerxes' years count from the latter half of the year BC 464 (not BC 465), so his seventh year was during BC 458 to 457.

<sup>\*1</sup> The 490 years started "from the issue of the decree to restore Jerusalem" [Daniel 9:24-27] and terminated at the end of the 490th. Year. This is "determined/fixed." So each year followed directly after the previous year. There were no gaps within the 490 years.

<sup>\*4</sup> Spring AD 30: The Lord Jesus was executed in the "midst" of the seven years in which the New Covenant was "confirmed." #

<sup>\*5</sup> Autumn AD 33: The baptism of first Gentiles completed the seven years in which the New Covenant was "confirmed" [Acts 10 & 11].@
